

BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE

Please find below details pertaining to the Book of Remembrance which is on permanent display at the crematorium and provides an inexpensive yet lasting record and memorial to those persons cremated at Mansfield & District Crematorium.

The Book of Remembrance is in three volumes, hand made, covered in natural calf vellum, richly tooled, with leaves of sheepskin vellum which will be lettered by hand by skilled craftsmen.

A page is provided for each day of the year and the book, in a protective cabinet, will be opened each day at the appropriate page, so that entries may be seen on each anniversary of the date of death for many years to come.

A few samples of suitable entries are shown below; these are only given as guidance and other entries may be chosen in accordance with the wishes of relatives or friends.

The minimum entry that will be accepted is of two lines, i.e. the first line to record the name of the deceased and the initial raised in gold, the desired entry appearing on the second line.

An application form is enclosed for your use, should you require it.
